

Course announcement

(for students registered on free of charge PE classes and sports sections)

In connection with the suspension of classes at the University of Warsaw due to the SARS-CoV-2 pandemic and consultation with the Vice-Rector of students and education quality of the University of Warsaw - Jolanta Choińska-Mika, Professor, Ph.D., below we would like to present you the conditions that must be fulfilled to obtain the credits for the physical education course in the current semester. The following solutions apply only to students who registered for the 2019/2020 summer semester through the token registration system for free PE classes and sports sections, **not to students registered for paid AZS classes.**

Sports-related online theoretical courses were prepared for students registered on free of charge PE classes and sports sections. Completing these courses is the only way to obtain credits in the 2019/2020 summer semester. Detailed information below:

- the courses are available on the COME UW platform <https://kampus-student2.ckc.uw.edu.pl/>. The login credentials are the same as in USOSweb and UL. After logging in, please select the option "Faculty and institute courses" from the list of available categories and then "Physical Education and Sport Centre" (SWFiS). You can also use the "My courses" tab, which we recommend
- each student has been automatically assigned to one or two courses on the platform, depending on the number of PE classes for which he/she registered in the current semester
- for students who registered on one PE class: in the platform's 'My courses' tab, a course will be displayed, named identically as in the USOS UL system, e.g. Aerobics (4023-O-AER1), Aqua fitness (4023-O-AQUA), etc.
- for students who registered on two PE classes in the current semester: in the platform's 'My courses' tab, the first course is displayed with the same rule, according to the above scheme: e.g. Aerobics (4023-O-AER1), while the second is displayed as "PE course for students registered on a second class in the 2019L semester "
- for students who registered on one PE class in the 2019L semester, the online PE course consists of 9 lectures (modules, thematic blocks)
- for students who registered on two PE class in the 2019L semester, the second online PE course consists of 7 lectures (modules, thematic blocks)
- the conditions for passing the online course/courses consist on reading the contents of all lectures and passing the tests regarding each of the lectures
- the tests consist of three single-choice closed questions - **it is required to give 100% correct answers to all questions in each test, and save them correctly in the system. The number of attempts is unlimited**
- passing the online course/courses (scoring 100% in all tests) will be equivalent to obtaining the credit/credits from PE classes in the current semester

- for students who have non-settled fees for PE tokens: the materials will be accessible only after their payment has been credited to the SWFiS UW's account (please notice that the payment takes about 5 working days to be processed)
- for students who enrolled in the current semester on free of charge **facultative** PE classes (after having already completed the obligatory PE classes or those classes are not compulsory for them), are requested to urgently contact the Deputy Director of Students Affairs – Marzena Polak, M.A.. Please note that as long as the stationary office hours are not possible, only e-mail contact is available: marzena.polak@uw.edu.pl
- the students who are completing the PE classes through the platform COME in the summer semester 2019/2020 will have the right to receive 30 additional PE tokens, as a compensation for the fact that the PE classes did not take place physically
- **the online courses will be available on the COME platform between the 05.05.2020 at 9:00 AM and the 07.06.2020 at 11:59 PM - we kindly inform you that this is the deadline.** The availability time of the materials has been extended to the maximum; however, technical limitations related to the service of roughly 8000 students determine the inability to re-open the access to the courses later on. Therefore, please ensure that all the answers are correct and that they have been saved in the system. **Even one incorrect answer will result in the failure of the course and it will not be possible to correct it at a later date, after the deadline.** At the same time, we suggest (due to the risk of server overloads) to not leave the attempt of solving the tests for the last day of the deadline
- we suggest that every student should log on to the platform before opening the courses to see if there are any problems
- the grades will be entered in the USOS system between the 08.06.2020 and the 19.06.2020

The students registered for paid AZS classes instead of the above courses are obliged to take part in remote classes, about which they were already informed by the Academic Sports Association (AZS UW) by e-mail.
